



Continuing our Learning at Home - Year 1

Reading	Please remember to listen to your child read every night. Share a range of fiction and non-fiction books and talk about the sentence structure. Where is the capital letter in the sentences? Where is the full stop? Can you find other words which also need a capital letter e.g. names, places, months, days of the week, titles and sub-headings? Do any of your sentences finish with a question mark? Does this change the way you would read the sentence out loud?
Mathematics	This week we have been reading and writing numbers to at least 20 in numerals and words. Can you write all of your numbers to 20 the right way round? Now practise writing all the WORDS for each number accurately. Start with numbers to 10 and, if you can do this, try writing all the WORDS for numbers up to 20, then 30. Please keep practising these over the next few weeks.
History	Next week we will be thinking about Remembrance and we will be learning about why it is important to remember different times in history. What can you find out about Remembrance Day? Why do we commemorate this day and what will be happening in Brentwood? How do you think people living at the time would have been feeling when they found out the war had ended?
