



## Continuing our Learning at Home - Year 2

<b>Reading</b>	Please remember to listen to your child read every night. When you encounter a new word in your reading book, use a dictionary to look up its meaning. Remember that the words in dictionaries are arranged in alphabetical order and you can use this to help you to look up the word you need.
<b>Mathematics</b>	Practise telling the time using o'clock, half past, quarter past and quarter to the hour on an analogue clock. Where will the hour and minute hands be at quarter past 5, half past 7, 12 o'clock and quarter to 10? If the hour hand is on the 8 and the minute hand is on the twelve, what will the time be?
<b>Friendship Week</b>	Write a recipe for Friendship. Think about what qualities you look for in a friend and use this to create your own friendship recipe. You could illustrate your recipe or design a poster on the computer.
