<b>Reading</b>	Next week we will be exploring poetry. Share a range of poems and rhymes. Select your favourite poem and learn it by heart so that you can share it with your family and friends. Pay attention to the rhythm and rhyme of the poem you are reciting.
<b>Mathematics</b>	This week we have been learning about time. How many clocks can you find in your home? Do they look like the clock faces we have been using at school? Can you tell someone when the clock shows 4 o'clock, or 6 o'clock? Now see if you can tell the time to half past the hour. See if you can notice the time at different points during the day - what time do you get out of bed on a school day? What time do you have breakfast on a Saturday? What time do you go to bed at?
<b>Splendid Skies</b>	Using the internet safely find out about extreme weather conditions, such as floods, drought, hurricanes, tornados, slippery roads, fallen trees and hose-pipe bans. Imagine the consequences of these weather events for those involved. In which seasons do you think these types of weather might occur?
