



## Continuing our Learning at Home – Year 2

<b>Writing</b>	Write a recount of something you have done over the weekend. Try to use a different word to begin each sentence and add some exciting words. Plan each sentence before you write it. Say it aloud to check it makes sense, write it and then check it carefully. Make sure that each sentence is carefully punctuated with a capital letter and a full stop. When you have written down everything you would like to share, read your work back carefully to check it makes sense and is well punctuated.
<b>Mathematics</b>	Can you identify the number of tens and ones (units) in two-digit numbers? 24=2 tens and 4 ones 35=3 tens and 5 ones Which number is 9 tens and 3 ones? Once you can do this, try working out how many hundreds there are in the following numbers: 127, 245, 117, 354.
<b>Topic:</b> <b>Muck, Mess and Mixtures</b>	Science focus: Explore different soap products at home to see which make the best bubbles. You could try using washing up liquid, bubble bath, hand soap and non-biological washing powder. Use a whisk, straw or sponges to create bubbles. Take photographs or draw pictures to show your results. Then experiment to see which bubbles last the longest.
