



## Continuing our Learning at Home - Year 2

<b>Reading</b>	Please remember to read at home every night. Share a range of different fiction books. Discuss the different story themes within your books and link them to your own personal experiences. For example: if the book is about a birthday party, think about a party you have been to and talk about how it compares with the party within the story.
<b>Mathematics</b>	Practise finding and recalling all pairs of numbers which total 20. (eg: 19+1, 15+5, 16+4). Remember that if you know all pairs of numbers which make 10 then you can use this information to help you. Play games such as <i>fast 20</i> to help you quickly recall the pairs of numbers: I say 15, you say 5, You say 10, I say 10
<b>Topic:</b> <b>Muck, Mess and Mixtures</b>	<b>Design and Technology/Geography focus:</b> Look carefully at the food products you have at home and find out which countries they originate from? Make a list and locate the places they have come from on an atlas. Which foods have travelled the furthest and which have travelled the shortest distance?
