





Continuing our Learning at Home - Year 1 - Y1FA and Y1P

Writing	Write a recount of something you have done over the weekend. Try to use a different word to begin each sentence and add some exciting words. Plan each sentence before you write it. Say it aloud to check it makes sense, write it and then check it carefully. Make sure that each sentence is carefully punctuated with a capital letter and a full stop. Don't forget to use the pronoun 'I' correctly when talking about yourself. When you have written down everything you would like to share, read your work back carefully to check it makes sense and is well punctuated.
Mathematics	Please practise writing the numbers zero to five in figures, words and using pictures. Here is an example as to how you could set it out: 3 three   Please bring your work in to put on our class display. Can you count forwards and backwards to and from 20? How high can you count? Challenge yourself to read different numbers at home or on your way to and from school - e.g. car registration numbers, timers on cookers, door numbers, page numbers in books etc. What is the largest number you have seen?
Focus country	Can you show a grown-up where Australia (Y1P) and Kenya (Y1FA) are on a map or globe? Can you now find the British Isles? Create a poster inviting people to visit your class country. Include colour and think about the places they could visit and the things they might see there.
